6 Tips

- 1. Too much trash? Purchase Pay-As-You-Throw Blue Bags at any local OnCue Express or the Convenience Collection Center (807 S. Perkins Road).
- Leave at least five feet between each trash and recycle cart and from any obstacles, including Blue Bags, parked cars, poles and mailboxes.
- 3. Opt into the Curbside Single-Stream Recycling Program by calling 405-742-8269 and providing the following information:
 - Name on your City of Stillwater Utility Bill
 - Service Address
 - Telephone and Email
 - Select Recycle Cart Size (35-, 64- and 96-gallon carts available.)
- 4. Residential customers are allowed to schedule up to two special cleanups at your service address within any 12-month period for no additional charge.
- **5.** Recyclable items are accepted for free at the Convenience Collection Center. Go to stillwater.org for hours of operation and a full list of accepted items and fee structure for special items.
- 6. Residential customers may schedule the pick-up of moving boxes and other packing materials at no additional charge.
